## SECTION VIII— APPRENTICE WAGE SCHEDULE - 2017

The employer agrees to pay not less than the following wage rate to the apprentice during each period of apprenticeship. Each period represents six months, two periods each year, for a total of eight periods over the duration of the four year apprenticeship. This wage scale shows the **minimum wage** an apprentice can be paid for the period he/she has reached during the course of the four year program. The employer is of course, free to pay a higher wage than the minimum but may not pay a lower wage.

A wage survey of all active and or current Participating Employers has been completed on the above date to arrive at the established journeyman hourly rate listed above. **The journeyman hourly wage rate shall be reviewed and adjusted annually (38H-16.00(e)(4), FAC).**
