Enrollment Open for 2011-2012

We are currently enrolling students for classes to start in January 2012 class. This class will be open to 1st year apprentices only and will take place until mid July, 2012. The apprentices will then follow the normal September through May class schedule for the remainder of their apprenticeship. If you have any apprentices that are interested in attending school, please have them call our office to schedule an appointment to fill out their paperwork. As soon as they enroll in school they can begin to count their on-the-job hours for apprenticeship. This will help to ensure that they will not be short hours and months in the trade when they graduate in their fourth year.
