- Test smoke and carbon monoxide alarms
- Make sure all major appliances are grounded

- If painting, use VOC paint

WORK RECORDS

We have quite a few apprentices that still have not turned in their work records for their on-the-job training (OJT) time as far back as the summer months. Monthly Work Records are a crucial and mandatory component to the completion of electrical apprenticeship. Apprentices are required to turn in their previous months work record in the first week of the following month. Each apprentice is required to have 12 months and 2000 hours of OJT per apprenticeship year. In order to complete the apprenticeship program, each apprentice must have 48 months of 8,000 hours of OJT recorded in their file. Certificates of promotion or completion will not be issued without OJT hours complete.
