## A few reminders as we start the 2017-2018 school year.

- Students are to call the office when they will be absent – prior to class.
- If it is a work-related absence, the contractor or supervisor on the job is to call the apprenticeship office. Please be aware that a “work related” absence is still considered an absence.
- Students are to turn in the monthly work records to the apprenticeship office no later than the 1<sup>st</sup> Thursday of the following month.

## Please be aware that due to Hurricane Irma, our class schedule has been amended for 2017-2018.

The State of Florida requires that each apprentice have a minimum of 144 classroom instructional hours to complete their apprenticeship year. As a result of the cancellation of classes from the storm, our schedule has been revised and there is now a maximum of 6 absences each apprentice is allowed throughout the 2017-2018 school year. Attendance and grades, as well as OJT hours will show on the apprentice’s monthly grade report, which is enclosed. Should an apprentice have an unanticipated circumstance arise during the course of the school year regarding absences, please contact the apprenticeship office to discuss.
